Allergic reaction caused by wigs

Two party wigs where bought at Kalaskompaniet in Täby Centrum. The wigs where used by two cousins for a shorter while on a Friday and for about four hours the next day on Saturday night. On Sunday morning the mother who reported the wigs to the Consumer Agency took her daughter to the hospital since she was clearly affected both physically as well as mentally. It later turned out the cousin also had turned ill. Both girls had rashes and were swollen on cheeks, chin, neck, forehead, ears and eyes. They had severe itch and pain in and around the red areas. See pictures below. Both girls where so affected that they had to stay home for some days. The matter was sent to the Swedish Chemical Inspection who saved the information but closed the matter since they did not know what chemical substance to search for.
